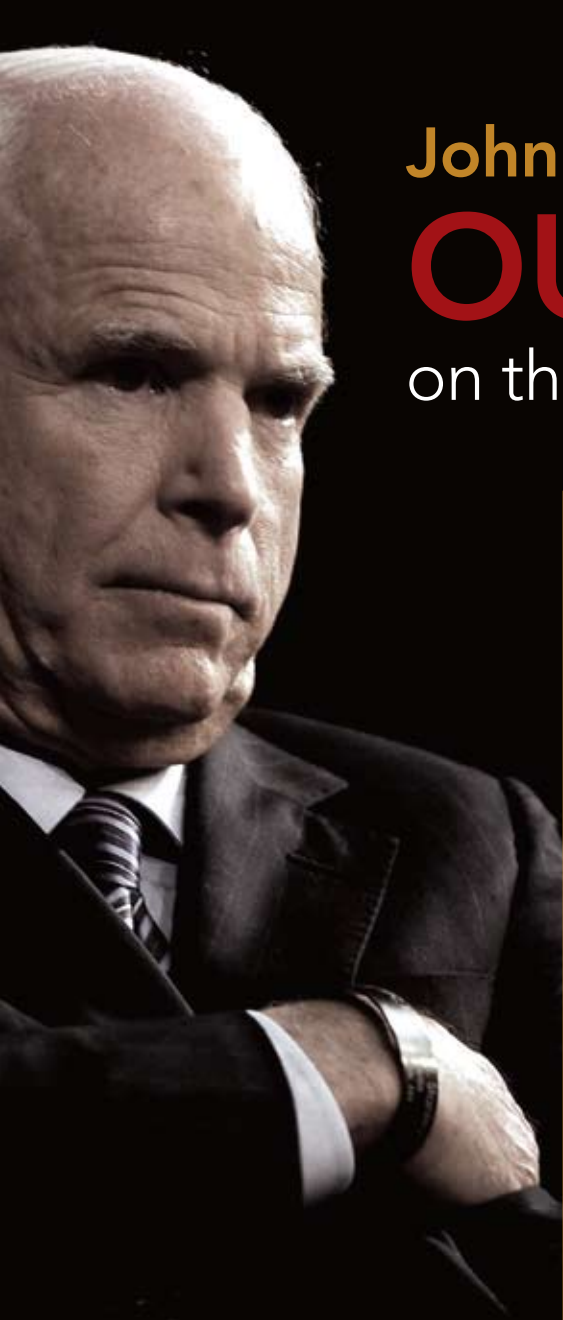

- > John McCain opposed the Violence Against Women Act, which ensures rape victims are not charged for the emergency exams used to prosecute their attackers. While Sarah Palin was mayor of Wasilla, rape victims were forced to pay for these exams, which cost up to \$1,200.³
