Please tell us whether you think Planned Parenthood should or should not be barred from receiving federal money for providing each of these services. Planned Parenthood health centers carry out almost 1,000,000 screenings for cervical cancer every year. Do you think it should or should not be barred from receiving federal money to help provide this service?
