

Medication Abortion Appointment Information & Instructions Under COVID-19

Prior to your appointment:

- Under COVID-19, we are committed to keeping patients and staff safe and this means limiting the time you are in our health center. Due to this, **the first part of your visit will be done over the phone the morning of your appointment** and the second part is when you come to the health center to get any testing and the medications. We will be calling you the morning of your visit and will need to talk with you while you are in a confidential setting. If we are unable to reach you ahead of time, we will ask you to wait outside the health center and complete the phone intake. If waiting outside is not possible, we will complete the intake in the health center.
- To reduce your contact and time in the center during the COVID pandemic, **you may not have to do an ultrasound** on the day of your visit. If you're interested in a shorter visit with no ultrasound, **please do a home pregnancy test on the day of the appointment or within 3 days of your appointment**. You will undergo screening during the phone intake to see if you qualify not to have an ultrasound.
