

2013 LEGISLATIVE SCORECARD

Planned Parenthood Votes Colorado compiles legislative scorecards to educate and inform voters about the record of support for reproductive health of current members of the Colorado Senate and Colorado House. The information presented is based on votes on key legislation related to reproductive health and rights.



LEGISLATIVE FOCUS

During the 2013 Legislative session in Colorado, PPVC focused its efforts into four major categories: Health, Justice, Pro-Women, and Equality.



HEALTH

Colorado's women, families, and youth are healthier.

- HB-1081 establishes stronger definitions for comprehensive sex education taught in public schools.
- SB-200 expands Medicaid eligibility to 160,000 additional Coloradans.
- SB-230 ensures ongoing access to family planning providers for Colorado women and families.



JUSTICE

A criminal justice loophole is now closed.

- HB-1154 addressed a gap in Colorado statutes for women who lose a wanted pregnancy as a result of criminal acts, while still protecting access to abortion.



PRO-WOMEN

Anti-women bills were defeated.

- HB-1032, 1033, 1131 and SB-55, 56 each would have placed undue burden on women seeking abortion services or would have banned the procedure outright. All were defeated.



EQUALITY

New laws create a more inclusive Colorado.

- HB-1303, SB-11, and SB-33 make sure Colorado has modern elections, relationship recognition, and access to higher education.
