

2024 Legislative Scorecard

Planned Parenthood Affiliates of California (PPAC) represents the seven separately incorporated Planned Parenthood affiliates in California, operating more than 100 health centers and serving nearly one million patients a year. PPAC advocates on legislative, fiscal, and regulatory issues that impact sexual and reproductive health care, health equity, sexual health education, and access to affordable and quality health care, including abortion.

The PPAC Scorecard is intended to provide the public with information about how their state legislators voted on these important issues and represents the top priorities for a given year based on legislative votes and actions. The PPAC Scorecard considers a member's vote or action during a critical opportunity to vote and/or their role in procedurally holding or delaying a priority bill. The scores listed are based on California legislators' actions on a floor vote for the following PPAC sponsored legislation: SB 1131, AB 2339, AB 2085, AB 2099, SB 959, and AB 2442. In addition to our top priorities, PPAC supported more than 100 bills and budget items impacting Planned Parenthood patients, operations, and our mission. This includes bills related to maternal health, social determinants of health, STI and HIV testing and prevention, health care coverage and payments, foster youth wellbeing, LGBTQ+ rights, behavioral health, intimate partner violence, access to comprehensive education, and health equity.

Description of Scored Legislation

SB 1131 (Gonzalez) Streamline Family Planning Program Requirements - streamlines family planning program certification by addressing barriers to the Family PACT program's clinic certification process to improve the ability for health care providers to serve almost 2 million Californians who rely on Family PACT.

AB 2339 (Aguilar-Curry) Improve Access to Telehealth - Would have expanded Medi-Cal coverage of asynchronous telehealth services for sensitive services and addressed barriers to accessing care via health care mobile apps and other asynchronous modalities for the nearly 15 million Californians on Medi-Cal.

AB 2085 (Bauer-Kahan) Preserve Health Center Permitting - Prohibits municipal interference with the delivery of constitutionally protected health care services by establishing a streamlined ministerial approval process for development of new health centers.

AB 2099 (Bauer-Kahan) Protecting Reproductive Health Clinics - Strengthens the enforcement of the FACE Act by updating penalties for FACE Act violations that intimidate and hinder patients from accessing constitutionally protect sexual and reproductive health care and providers from providing that care.

SB 959 (Menjivar) Ensure Comprehensive Access to Information - Establishes an online resource that offers information to patients, health care providers, and families about available support for TGI individuals and their families in California.

AB 2442 (Zbur) Expedite Licensure for Providers committed to Gender-Affirming Care - Would have ensured that licensure applications for providers of gender-affirming care were prioritized to ensure a robust network of health care providers in the state.
