HB2568 by Faison (SB2465 by Gresham)	As introduced, requires any facility in which more than 50 abortions were performed during the previous calendar year to post a sign informing patients that a chemical abortion may be reversed following the first dose of a two-dose treatment; requires a patient to receive similar notice prior to and after having the first dose of a chemical abortion; provides criminal penalties and civil actions for any violation of the act. HB2576 by Ragan (SB2215 by Bowling)	As introduced, prohibits the provision of sexual identity change therapy to prepubescent minors; prohibits the provision of sexual identity change therapy to minors who have entered puberty unless a parent or guardian has written recommendations for the therapy from at least three physicians; punishes violations as child abuse; designates violations by healthcare professionals as professional misconduct. HB2795 by Johnson G (SB2640 by Robinson)	As introduced, requires a health insurance entity on health plans issued, delivered, executed, amended, or renewed on or after July 1, 2020, to include in that health plan a special enrollment period that allows the enrollment of a pregnant individual at any time after the commencement of the pregnancy as certified by a healthcare professional acting within the healthcare professional's scope of practice. HB2709 by Lamar (SB2435 by Gilmore)	As introduced, removes the preexisting condition exclusion from the mandated insurance coverage requirement for pregnancy. HB2434 by Camper (SB2583 by Robinson)	As introduced, deletes the family life curriculum required for schools located in certain counties that only allows students to receive education on sexual risk avoidance through abstinence; requires each LEA and public charter school that serves any of the grades kindergarten through 12 to provide students with medically accurate, age-appropriate sex education that teaches students about abstinence, contraception, consent, and how to develop healthy relationships and communication skills. HB2296 by Van Huss (SB2069 by Pody)	As introduced, authorizes local governments to take special censuses that include unborn children; requires that any state funds distributed and allocated to local governments based on population use such special census figures. HB2263 by Lamberth (SB2196 by Johnson)	As introduced, extends the time, from 30 to 60 days, within which a physician accused of performing a partial-birth abortion may delay trial in order to allow the state medical board to determine whether the physician's conduct was necessary to save the life of the mother. HB0077 by Van Huss (SB1236 by Pody)	As introduced, prohibits abortions from the point a fetal heartbeat is detected; creates exceptions.
